



Instructions to Receive Incoming International Transfers

SWIFT International Bank ID / **Offline Only ** Univest is not a member of SWIFT****
Please Note that the Univest SWIFT code (UNTRUS33) is not valid for receiving wire transfers and should NOT be used on an incoming wire transfer. Doing so could result in the wire failing to reach Univest.

The originating bank must forward funds through **their** US Correspondent Bank as the ‘*Intermediary Bank*’. Funds will then be directed by the Intermediary bank to Univest Bank and Trust Co. identified as the ‘*Beneficiary Bank*’. It is important to include our full bank name and address along with the above noted US Bank ‘ABA’ Routing Number. (Please note that the US banking system has not adopted the International Bank Identification Number “IBAN” format.)
